### Substance Use Treatment for Medi-Cal beneficiaries including those on a Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan

Medi-Cal beneficiaries can receive substance abuse services through the San Diego County Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System. Services are typically provided by the County's network of contracted providers, which may be accessed by calling the San Diego Access & Crisis Line at (888) 724-7240

#### San Diego County Access & Crisis Line

The San Diego County Access & Crisis Line can assist Medi-Cal beneficiaries including those on a Medi-Cal Managed Care Plan to find the appropriate substance use treatment program. When a Medi-Cal beneficiary calls the San Diego County Access & Crisis Line, a Masters Level trained Clinician will provide a telephone assessment to help the caller determine exactly what kind of substance use treatment they may need and provide a referral to a treatment program covered by the San Diego County Drug Medi-Cal Program.

#### **Consumer Center for Health Education & Advocacy**

The Consumer Center for Health Education & Advocacy ("Consumer Center") helps consumers understand how to use physical and behavioral health services. If a consumer feel his/her substance abuse treatment needs are not being met, the Consumer Center can inform them of their rights and work to remove barriers to needed care. **The Consumer Center for Health Education & Advocacy number is: (877) 734-3258.**
